

LANCASHIRE ASSOCIATION OF CHANGE RINGERS

ESTABLISHED 1876 RE-CONSTITUTED 1879

OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the Association are to promote the art and science of change ringing as an integral part of the Church's life and work by means of the following:

- 1. The ringing of bells for services and other appropriate occasions in the life of the Church and community.
- 2. The fostering of good relations with the Church and community and the furtherance of the appreciation of bells and bellringing amongst the general public.
- 3. The recruitment and training of bell ringers.
- 4. The promotion of good fellowship and cooperation amongst bellringers, including arranging ringing meetings and other Association activities.
- 5. The proper care and maintenance of bells, belfries and ringing rooms.
- 6. The support of bell restoration and installation by the provision of financial, technical and other resources.
- 7. The development of awareness, and conservation, of items of historical and local interest associated with bells and bellringing.

RULES

- 1. The Association shall be known as THE LANCASHIRE ASSOCIATION OF CHANGE RINGERS, shall be affiliated to the Central Council of Church Bellringers, and shall consist of Honorary and Ringing Members.
- 2. Persons may be admitted as members of the Association at any committee, branch or general meeting if proposed and seconded by two members. Ringers may be provisionally elected if required to take part in a peal provided the members present are in favour, subject to such election being confirmed at a committee branch or general meeting. The member proposing such persons shall be responsible for the payment of their subscription whether the attempt be successful or not.
- 3. Any person, other than a ringer, subscribing the sum of ten pounds shall be admitted as an Honorary Life Member of the Association. Upon election, Ringing Members shall pay a minimum annual subscription of ten pounds, except in the case of juveniles under 18 years of age, whose annual subscription shall be a minimum of five pounds, due on the first day of January each year, such payment entitling the member to a Report of the year for which his subscription has been paid. The name of any Ringing Member two years in arrears shall be removed from the book but may be reinstated at the discretion of the Committee.
- 4. Any qualified Ringer not resident in the Association territory may be admitted as a Non-Resident Member on payment of a single subscription equal to the annual subscription of a Ringing Member, but such members shall have no vote at the meetings of the Association. If at any subsequent date he becomes resident in the Association territory he shall pay the ordinary yearly subscription of a Ringing Member. Any Ringing Member who goes to reside outside the Association territory may at his own request be transferred to the list of Non-Resident Members without further payment.
- 5. (a) The committee shall have the power to:
- (i) Approve the application from any permanently disabled member who is unable to take further part in practical ringing to be transferred to the list of Life Ringing Members without further payment.
- (ii) Grant Life Membership or Honorary Life Membership to those who have served the Association well over a long period.
- (iii) Award the office of Honorary Vice-President to any member who has given exceptional service to the Association, this office entitling them to vote at Committee Meetings.
- (b) Any member with 50 years continuous membership shall automatically become a Life Member
- 6. (a) The management of the Association shall be vested in a President, Vice-President, General Secretary, Peal Secretary, Report Secretary, Affiliation Scheme Secretary, Librarian, Treasurer,

Education Officer, Public Relations Officer, Fund Raising Co-Ordinator, Conservation Officer, Inspection & Maintenance Officer and Central Council Representatives and two representatives from each branch. These shall form the Central Committee, any five of whom shall form a quorum competent to transact the business of the Association provided all the Committee have been summoned. They shall have full power and control over the funds of the Association, and in any case of vacancy they shall have power to appoint any eligible member to office. They shall also have full power to co-opt, for a one year term, any member of the Association who has specialist expertise which the Committee may require.

- (b) The President, Vice-President, General Secretary, Peal Secretary, Report Secretary, Affiliation Scheme Secretary, Treasurer, Education Officer, Public Relations Officer, Fund Raising Co-Ordinator, Conservation Officer, Inspection & Maintenance Officer and Central Council Representatives shall be elected by ballot; the President, Peal Secretary, Treasurer, Education Officer, Fund Raising Coordinator and Conservation Officer one year, and the Vice-President, General Secretary, Report Secretary, Affiliation Secretary, Public Relations Officer and Inspection & Maintenance Officer, the next year. Central Council Representatives shall be elected in accordance with the constitution of the Central Council.
- (c) All nominations for general officers and members of the Central Council shall be in the hands of the General Secretary by the 31st October and a ballot vote shall be taken and the results announced before 31st December and the ballot figures published. No nominations shall be accepted unless nominees give their written consent. Nominees shall not be eligible if in arrears with their subscriptions. Ballot papers shall be issued only to Members, Life Ringing Members of known address or other Life Ringing Members who apply to the General Secretary. After nominations have been received a scrutineer shall be appointed by the Committee.
- (d) The Committee shall appoint a Librarian and a Safeguarding Officer who shall both become members of the Committee.
- (e)(i) The Committee will determine periodically a maximum annual amount that may be claimed by the Association's Central Council representatives as a contribution towards their expenses in attending the Central Council meeting.
- (ii) Any Ringing Member may claim reimbursement of actual, reasonable expenditure incurred in the course of carrying out duties on behalf of the Association. Any claims under this subsection will only be paid if supported by receipts or other evidence.
- (iii) All claims must be submitted to the Association Treasurer within 3 months of the end of the year in which the expenditure was incurred.
- (iv) Claims from Committee members must be approved by the Committee; claims from other members must be approved and submitted by the secretary of the claimant's home Branch.
- 7. The President, General Secretary, Peal Secretary and Treasurer shall be the Trustees, any two to sign cheques. The Trustees shall invest or otherwise deal with such sums as the Association may place in their hands in such a manner as the Committee may direct.
- 8. (a) The year (financial or otherwise) of the Association shall end on 31 December, and the Annual General Meeting of the Association shall take place not later than 30 April in each year for the purpose of receiving the Committee's report and the Treasurer's account, and for the transaction of the general business of the Association.
- (b) That an independent examiner should be appointed to examine the Association's annual accounts and prepare the Association's balance sheet, this examiner to be appointed by the Committee. The Committee shall meet not less than twice each year, in February and September, the date and the branch to be fixed by the committee.
- 9. The Annual General Meeting shall be held in each branch in turn and the minutes of this meeting shall be kept and signed.
- 10. No alterations or additions to these Rules shall be made except at the Annual General Meeting or at an Extraordinary General Meeting held under Rule 12. Two calendar months notice in writing of any proposed alteration shall be given to the General Secretary previous to the Annual General Meeting or the Extraordinary General Meeting taking place.
- 11. Any avoidable damage done at an Association meeting to bells or fittings by members shall be

made good at the expense of the Association.

- 12. An Extraordinary General Meeting may be called at any time by the General Secretary on request of the President or twenty members of the Association. The General Secretary shall give to the members three weeks notice at least of any special meeting, with the particulars of the business to be transacted, and such notice shall be deemed to have been given by sending a copy to each Tower Secretary to be displayed in the belfry, and also advertised in The Ringing World.
- 13. (a) The Association shall be divided into convenient branches, the management of which shall be conducted as hereinafter provided.
- (b) No tower shall be transferred from one branch to another without the written consent of a majority of the ringers at the tower concerned and after discussion by the Central Committee and with the approval of the Annual General Meeting of the Association.
- (c) The branch affairs shall be managed by a Chairman and/or Ringing Master, Secretary and Committee, the constitution of the Committee being decided by the Branch. Two of the Branch Committee shall represent the Branch on the Association Committee, it being advisable that one should be the Branch Secretary. The Branch Secretary shall be responsible for collecting subscriptions from:
- (i) All newly elected members
- (ii) All unattached Members of the Branch, and forwarding these subscriptions to the Gen Secretary.
- 14. A peal will only be accepted as being rung for the Association if:
- (a) It conforms to the Central Council regulations on peals.
- (b) All members taking part are current Ringing Members or Non-Resident Life Members of the Association.
- (c) Full details and peal booking fee (£1 per ringer), half of which to be donated to the Bell Restoration Fund, are received by the Peal Secretary:
- (i) For peals rung between 1 January and 16 December inclusive within four weeks of the peal being rung.
- (ii) For peals rung between 17 and 31 December inclusive by 14 January of the following year.

SAFEGUARDING POLICY

The Lancashire Association of Change Ringers (LACR) is committed to the protection of young ringers and fully supports the principles of the House of Bishops' Child Protection Policy. The LACR fully supports the Child Protection guidelines issued in March 2004 by the CCCBR, which cover the appointment of those with responsibility for tower management and training, and sensible procedures for day-to-day management of the tower in respect of protection and development of young people. These guidelines are consistent with the principles espoused by the House of Bishops' policy.

The LACR advises all Tower Captains to discuss the issue with their incumbent and PCC and agree appropriate local procedures. In general, the LACR recommends and encourages adoption of the CCCBR guidelines by dioceses, parishes and bell ringing bands as a practical measure to protect young ringers and maintain the open, welcoming and friendly environment that has characterised church bell ringing for many years.

BELL RESTORATION FUND OBJECTIVES AND RULES

- 1. The Fund shall be known as THE LANCASHIRE ASSOCIATION OF CHANGE RINGERS BELL RESTORATION FUND.
- 2. The object of the Bell Restoration Fund is to give financial assistance to churches incurring considerable outlay on installations by applying the income solely for the making of grants. The following shall be deemed to satisfy the requirements for an application for grant, viz:

Any major maintenance, repairs or new work to bells, frames and fittings, such as recasting, retuning, overhaul or augmentation and, where deemed appropriate by the LACR Committee, apparatus installed for sound control.

- 3. The Fund shall be administered by the Committee of THE LANCASHIRE ASSOCIATION OF CHANGE RINGERS who shall have power, after consideration of an application submitted in writing, to approve a grant from the Fund.
- 4. The President, General Secretary, Peal Secretary and Treasurer shall be the Trustees, any two to sign cheques. The Trustees shall invest or otherwise deal with such sums as the Association may place in their hands, in such a manner as the Committee may direct.
- 5. In the event of dissolution of the Fund, balances remaining shall be divided amongst the churches supporting the affiliation scheme for such charitable purposes as the Parochial Church Council think fit
- 6. An independent examiner shall be appointed to examine the annual accounts, the examiner to be appointed by the Committee.
- 7. No alteration or addition to these rules shall be made except at the Annual General Meeting. Two clear calendar months notice, in writing, of any proposed alteration which does not infringe the Fund's charitable validity in law shall be given to the General Secretary previous to the date of the meeting.

Note from the Committee (amended Sept 2015)

Members are reminded that applications for grants should be made in a timely manner & that no grants will be made from the Bell Restoration Fund without a written request from the Incumbent, Churchwardens or Church Secretary of the church concerned to the BRF sub committee convener:

Grant applications received between 1 Jan to 30 Jun will be considered in time for a proposal to be put to the September Committee Meeting.

Grant applications received between 1 July to 31 Dec will be considered in time for a proposal to be put to the February Committee Meeting.

Grants awarded but not claimed will lapse two years from the date of application if the work has not started by then.

As a general guide, the aim will be to offer a minimum of 10% towards the cost of qualifying work.

INSURANCE

The Association holds an insurance policy with Ecclesiastical Insurance, which provides personal accident cover to a limited group of unnamed members carrying out bell inspections on behalf of the Association. This policy also provides legal liability cover for all members of the Association. This would protect members in the event that they are found to be legally liable for accidents to third parties or damage to third party property. Many Churches will hold policies that provide similar cover to bellringers at their Church. Also, many household insurance policies provide similar cover for normal hobby activities. If you require further details or are aware of any incidents that may give rise to a claim under this policy, please contact the General Secretary.

SUBSCRIPTIONS

Ringing Members: a minimum of £10.00.

Under 18's: a minimum of £5.00.

Under Rule 3 these were due on the first day of the year. If you have not already paid your subscription, the General Secretary would be pleased to receive it as soon as possible.


MEMBERSHIP MOJO

All LACR members (Resident, Non-Resident and Life) are asked to manage their membership on the Membership Mojo system.

How to register as a member

This guide will take you through the steps you need to take to register as a member of LACR on our new membership software. More detailed information on Membership Mojo will be available on the LACR website during 2025.

Click on the link you have been sent or go to https://membermojo.co.uk/lacr and you will get to this screen.



Click on join us/ renew and then follow the instructions on the following screens.

Complete the form as applying for a new membership. Fields with a * must be completed. If you prefer to be known by a name that is not your actual first name, please put this in the first name box. This will mean any emails will use that name.

For members who do not have their own email address, registration can be done using another person's email address. The same email address may be used for more than one member. To ensure one person does not receive multiple copies of the same email, choose unsubscribe group emails for the additional users of the address.

A junior member will need to provide details of a responsible adult to receive communications for them. As you complete details for a junior member extra field will display for the adult's details. These can be those of an adult member or an adult who is not a ringer.

If you are a tower contact for a church with no ringing members join as an adult member but in notes state you are only a contact. We will set your status so you do not get asked to pay subs.

After submitting the form you will receive an email stating that your membership has been sent for approval.

An Administrator will confirm that you are a paid up member (or if you are a new member that you have been properly elected) and you will then receive a welcome email.

You then need to complete registration and pay this year's subs. There will be a link in the email you receive to confirm your membership has been approved. Use this to complete the application.

After completing the application, you will be presented with the checkout screen. Choose your method of payment. If your tower pays for you, choose via tower contact.

We encourage members to pay using Stripe online payments option if possible.

If you choose BACS cheque or standing order, you will be presented with the relevant payment details. Please ensure you do make the payment separately, quoting the M number you are given as part of the process of completing the payment.

You will receive an email confirming you have completed action

You will automatically receive emails for all members, such as requests for subs, which will come out each December ready for the following January and emails from the branch you are linked to. Emails will come from Lancashire Association of Change Ringers noreply.lacr@membermojo.co.uk

If you want to come back to your membership details at a later date to update them, you can sign in to do so from the home page.

If you need further help, please ask your Tower Captain, Branch Secretary or the General Secretary.

DUTY OF GENERAL OFFICERS

President

The President shall, if possible, attend and conduct the affairs at the Annual General Meeting, Committee Meetings and any Extraordinary General Meeting.

Hon General Secretary

The General Secretary shall attend, if possible, every General and Committee Meeting, receive the names of newly elected members, take a note of all correspondence, keep the minutes and remit all monies to the Treasurer. The General Secretary shall collect all subscriptions and relevant information to the ringing calendar from the tower leaders.

Hon Peal Secretary

The Peal Secretary shall keep a record of all peals rung for the Association, maintain peal records of individual members and collect all peal booking fees. A report of such activities shall be presented to the Annual General Meeting and published in the Annual Report.

Hon Treasurer

The Treasurer shall receive all monies of the Association with the exception of any Affiliation Fees paid into the Association's bank account directly by the Affiliation Scheme Secretary and shall acknowledge receipt of such without delay. He or she shall arrange for the duly elected Auditors to examine all the books and financial records and at the Annual General Meeting shall submit the audited financial statements comprising the Income and Expenditure Account and Balance Sheet.

Hon Affiliation Scheme Secretary

The Affiliation Scheme Secretary shall administer the Association's Affiliation Scheme in such a manner as the Committee may direct.

Hon Librarian

The Librarian shall be responsible for the upkeep of the library and its contents.

Hon Report Secretary

The Report Secretary shall collect the necessary information and attend to the printing, issuing and distribution of the Annual Report.

Education Officer

The Education Officer shall meet the education and training needs of the Association by arranging training days with the help of a subcommittee made up of Branch representatives (as at present). He or she shall provide information and assistance on education and training to Branches and towers.

Safeguarding Officer

The Safeguarding Officer shall be familiar with legislation regarding safeguarding and understand the procedures for registration and issues around safeguarding and abuse; act as a resource to Association and Branch Officers to aid compliance to the Safeguarding Policy; Provide a copy of the policy and any relevant procedures and guidelines to Branch Secretaries for dissemination to Branch Officers and Tower Captains; ensure that any concerns of inappropriate behaviour are reported to the relevant authorities, including the Bishop's Advisor for Safeguarding in the Diocese within the Association; review the Policy annually to ensure compliance with relevant legislation; maintain appropriate records where necessary; act with discretion and confidentiality if handling personal information and data. Consult with the President on any contentious issues.

Inspection and Maintenance Officer

The Inspection and Maintenance Officer shall co-ordinate bell inspections by liaising with Branch and Diocesan bell advisors. He or she shall promote planned maintenance of bells and equipment.

Public Relations Officer

The Public Relations Officer shall develop good public relations by contact with local Churches, Church publications and with the media (both locally and nationally when appropriate). He or she shall provide guidance to Branches and towers on local public relations and recruitment.

DUTY OF GENERAL OFFICERS

Fund Raising Coordinator

The Fund Raising Coordinator shall coordinate the organisation of fund raising activities for the Bell Restoration Fund at Association level. He or she shall provide information and guidance to Branches and towers on fund raising at local level.

Conservation Officer

The Conservation Officer shall compile and maintain details of items of historical and local interest associated with bells and bell-ringing with reference to national guidelines on conservation where they exist. He or she shall assist and advise Branches and towers on conservation work proposed or required.

HOW DO I GET TO BE AN OFFICER?

Simple-each year, around the end of August, your Branch Secretaries will be informed of the posts up for election at the end of the year. Also, details will normally be published in the newsletter.

Nominations must be received by the General Secretary by the end of October for posts which will normally be taken with effect from the AGM the following April. This delay is there to allow sufficient time for a postal ballot to be completed and the result announced before the end of the calendar year.

Nominations should consist of an individual proposer and seconder (or a Branch can nominate a person) and a signed statement from the nominee that they are happy to stand.

If there is more than one nomination for a post and a vote is required, then the nominee may also need to provide brief biographical details to help the voters make their choice!

If you are interested in holding a particular office, please make your interest known to your fellow ringers and Branch members and speak to the person currently in the job to find out what it involves.

MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

"There's nothing like a jolly good disaster to get people doing things" (Prince, now King, Charles)

I wasn't going to find a quote for this year, because last Years hasn't appeared after I'd written it, and I was more than irked!

I have to say that 2024 has been a bit of a disaster - my quote to the rest of the Trustees was "The Association seems to be upside -down"

First, let me apologise on behalf of the Trustees and the Officers about the lack of an Annual Report for 2023 - this has been for many reasons which would take up a lot of pages and my time. Suffice it to say it looks like the Annual Report for 2023 isn't going to appear after all, and subsequently, the 2024 Annual Report will have to reflect it. I am grateful to Pilar for running with this and trying to sort it out - even having to resort to doing it clerically. The membership Mojo is still not right, we seem to have lost over 300 members, but I'm assured a lot of this was because the old tower lists had lots of lapsed ringers on them, and even some no longer alive.

There were 3 Committee meetings this Year, the extra one was in June, which will be repeated in 2025 with the LACR 150th Anniversary coming up in 2026.

I was present at the Striking Competition at Tuebrook in May; with 9 teams entering (although there were 11 till the night before) and a good time was had by all. Philip Earis came up to judge for us and thanks must be expressed to him. In 2025, the LACR Striking Competition will, however, revert to its old October slot, to give branches time to hold their local ones, or basically to get a team together.

I attended the dedication of the ring of 8 at Over Kellet in February. The day before was the Open Day, which was very good. A well esteemed ringer from the Association texted me "did they forget to tune them?", to which the reply went back, "Thats the problem - they didn't", which was followed by the reply "Oh dear!" (I still have that text). Although at Church Kirk, they had been Warner bells of not the best era, these bells were wrecked by over-tuning and most of the year has been spent trying to get Taylors to retract their digit, with every letter sent to them having to be chased up, sometimes more than once. After all the contra temps the result has been the 2 new trebles have been taken away and replaced with another 2 of a different profile, which has made the ring a little brighter; but the 7th is still stuck at the back of the ring, sounding like a mangled old pan which, (and we will continue to battle with Taylors) should also have been replaced. On a better note (see what I did there?), the dedication of the new 10 at Rochdale took place in October and are a very good, usable ring. Barnoldswick were augmented to 8 in July; In September I had the privilege of ringing the first peal on the Treble, which the Association gave in memory of Colin Ashworth.

Our Treasurer, Andy Kayll has *almost* now got us right with the banking.... this has been tortuous throughout the Year thanks to HSBC, but hopefully we can now transfer money over without having to have it written in 4 different blood types!

Elizabeth Joan Cosnett 1936 – 2024

Elizabeth was born and bred in the Liverpool suburb of Wavertree. She read English Literature at St. Hugh's College, Oxford, and was an English teacher for almost forty years, the majority of them at St. Katherine's College, now Liverpool Hope University.

Elizabeth was introduced to ringing at Liverpool Parish Church during the early 1960s, through her great friend and teaching colleague, Gwen Howlett. She was elected a member of the Lancashire Association in 1964, going on to ring two peals and numerous quarter-peals. She was a loyal member of the Pierhead band for over half a century and a devoted member of the church's congregation throughout her entire life.

As well as ringing, Elizabeth was a prolific and award-winning hymn-writer. Indeed, her hymns have been published in hymnals worldwide.

Elizabeth made the decision to retire from ringing in Spring 2015, just before her 79th birthday. Although she did not enjoy good health during the final years of her life, she was well looked after in residential care, where she died peacefully on 22nd January 2024. Following her memorial service at Liverpool Parish Church, Elizabeth's ashes were scattered at the base of the tower, in the heart of the city that had been her home for eighty-eight years.

William John Thomas 1934 – 2024

John was born in Ellesmere Port but spent most of his married life in Rainhill. After National Service, he completed his apprenticeship in carpentry, working latterly as Clerk of Works for Knowsley Borough Council. John was a very modest man of many talents. For instance, he built his own house from scratch, could sew, cook and repair anything.

He learned to ring at St. Ann's Rainhill in 1996 when the light ring of six was installed and was elected a member of the Lancashire Association in 1997. His meticulous carpentry skills were put to good use, both at St. Ann's and at nearby St. Bart's, where he assisted the Merseyside Bell Restoration Group in the refurbishment of the ringing chambers.

Ringing brought great pleasure to John, especially when his daughter Fleur and granddaughter Naomi learned to ring. He often expressed regret at not having discovered the pleasures of The Exercise at a younger age. He recognised the importance of visiting other towers to gain experience of ringing heavier bells. In particular, he enjoyed attending practices at neighbouring Prescot for a number of years.

Sadly, poor health forced John to retire from ringing around twelve years ago, but he was a loyal member of the St. Ann's band for some fifteen years, as well as a long-serving member of the congregation. John died peacefully on 7th May 2024. The bells were rung both before and after his funeral at St. Ann's Rainhill.

Robert 'Bob' Sutcliffe 29th October 1944 - 19th May 2024

Bob was a quiet man and few knew of his background. Born in Bacup, he moved to Burnley in 1947. Following matriculation from Burnley Grammer School, he undertook a year's work experience on a farm near Kendal, in order to attend Myerscough College, where he qualified as a farming advisor. Bob was successful in gaining a job with the Agricultural Training Board, initially working and living in Harrogate before moving to Wigtown, Cumbria. Whilst based at Wigtown, he bought and completely renovated an old farmhouse.

After a short time, he fancied a change, and went walking and working in France. When the money ran out, he returned to the UK, and decided to make his lifelong passion of sailing into a career, and studied for his Yachtmaster Offshore Certificate, which allowed him to skipper a vessel up to 150 miles from shore. Further qualifications followed, and sailing boats for their owners became his living



After a number of years, he stepped back from both captaining crewing boats, to set up his own horticultural business in the Ribble Valley, where he maintained private gardens and took up walking. However, he did not give up sailing, as he bought his own yacht ~ the 'Cinq Mille' a 27-foot Sabre, berthed at Glasson Dock near Lancaster, which, surprise surprise, cost £5000. Besides sailing trips from Glasson to Ireland, the Isle of Mann and the West Coast of Scotland.

During 2010 Bob, along with another late ringer Brian Brookes, were 'press ganged' into trying their hands at Bellringing by our late esteemed ringer John Collier. They both took to this and Bob especially became a competent ringer. He mainly rang at St Helen Waddington for Sunday services and weddings, but also rang at all the other Ribble Valley towers. He joined in with the first RV ringing tour which ventured into 'Yorkshire' in 2022.

On retirement from gardening, his white van received an extensive internal makeover, of sorts, and he toured the West Coast of Scotland ~ the 'Man in the Van', perhaps a suitable subject for Alan Bennett to consider?

Bob will be sadly missed.

CHRYSTINE BUTCHER 14th September 1939 – 22nd May 2024

It is with great sadness that the Fylde branch learned of Chrystine's passing on 25 May. As branch secretary for many years and a keen ringer at St John's Lytham she made a significant contribution to the progression of ringing in the branch and in particular at her home tower.

Chrystine was born in St Anne's on 14 September to Constance and Harold Lord. She attended Queen Mary's School being head girl there in 1957-58. She joined the WRAF in October 1958 in Air Traffic Control on fighter squadrons and had numerous postings. She married Flight Lieutenant Terry Butcher in April 1966. She then worked at BAC/BAE in Flight Operations from 1973 until November 1999. Her sons David and Richard were born in 1967 and 1969. She had four grandchildren.

Her devotion and commitment to the church of St John the Divine in Lytham ensured that it prospered, working as PCC secretary for thirty years. In 1984 she helped to form a new band of bellringers to ring again after a thirty year silence.

After attending courses in Hereford and Ripon, Chrystine was determined that the bells be pealed. After a first quarter peal on 23 April 1989 (on the second to Bob Doubles) and a second a month later, on 7 October 1989 Chrystine rang her one and only peal of 5040 changes, Bob Doubles in 2 hours 46 minutes. I won't repeat what she said immediately afterwards; only that the bells needed to be rehung with new bearings. As tower captain, she instigated and completed the project in 1992. No problem that the church had just used the last of its funds doing the roof; we would have to just raise the £14.000 ourselves.

She was now secretary of the Fylde branch, supporting and keeping the thirteen ringable towers together too, and did so until 2014. She rang a total of 36 quarter peals, 18 at St John's and the rest at St Cuthbert's, St Peter's, St Joseph's and St Anne's. Twenty four were Grandsire, two Plain Bob Doubles, and on six bells she rang nine of Plain Bob and one of Cambridge Minor.

Chrystine understood that bells were sacred objects with ringing to be dedicated primarily for services. She was also of the opinion that bells should be rung open, to celebrate life – hence the bells remaining unmuffled at her funeral. The inscription "Devotion, Death and Happiness bid us sound" was more than applicable as we rang for her funeral.

Thank you Chrystine for looking after the church and for sounding the bells. God Bless!

THE AFFILIATION SCHEME

The Affiliation Scheme was first discussed in 1914 but despite various draft documents was not passed by the committee until 1930. The original letter to churches is lost, but the scheme was set up so that churches, whether they had ringers or not, could be made aware that grants from the Association were available towards the cost of bell repair work. A later letter to a local church states that; "Your support has been of considerable help in the establishment of a Bell Restoration Fund" and that "Members may seek advice from the Association on any matter relating to bells and bell-towers, and expert advice can be at their service." You do not need to be affiliated to the scheme to receive a grant from the Association. At present, grants are running at 10-12½% of work proposed, which is good and well worth the minimum donation of £10 per year. Donation request letters go out in October to be replied to by December 31st and the church name should then appear in the list of affiliating churches in the Annual Report issued in April. Donations may be made by standing order or by bank transfer if required. Please contact the Treasurer for details.

This is my second report as Affiliation Scheme Secretary, so I hope that people are getting used to requests coming from me. This year we have received donations from 56 towers, totalling £1,348.00. We have made payments from the Bell Restoration Fund to 3 projects that have completed this year, at Barnoldswick, Rochdale & Whalley.

While we have been lucky in recent years in receiving substantial legacies, the contributions made or promised to projects is reducing that fund noticeably, so we are very grateful to all the towers who have contributed as this does ensure a continuing income for us. As we approach our 150th anniversary, I will be increasing my efforts to reach out to all the towers in the Association to encourage them to consider becoming an affiliate.

INSPECTION & MAINTENANCE OFFICER

This year has seen a few projects progressing throughout the Association, some with, and some without an input from the Association.

In terms of advice to towers, a visit to Pilling, St. John the Baptist was requested. This arose owing to a piece of stone falling into the church from under the ringing room floor. Although this was not large, it fell a long way and could have hurt someone badly if it struck them directly. Ringing had been temporarily suspended, so it was important to act promptly.

As with all towers, there is movement when the bells ring and it is natural for people not involved in bellringing to be more concerned. The thought is that it has happened as a direct result of the ringing and may be an indication of a worsening situation.

Primarily, it was important to ensure that the tower movement was not excessive and that the frame was well anchored – this proved to be the case. The piece of stone that fell off was from where the ringing room floor rests on the wall, effectively just facing stone, but was possibly sheared off by someone standing on the floor above. This is a substantial tower and the steel frame is relatively new, less than 40 years old. Having established that there were no immediate concerns about the tower, whilst there, it was sensible to check the rest of the installation.

The inspection showed that one particular action has been very effective in keeping this belfry in a state of good repair – the installation of substantial wire mesh up at the louvres, keeping the wildlife out. A report on other minor findings was issued.

A grant had been offered to Whalley St. Mary the Virgin & All Saints for refurbishment of the fittings to bring these bells, just a century old, back to the easy-going ring they should be. As is required, it is necessary to check that granted work is done as proposed. A brief inspection confirmed that this is the case and it is hoped another century has been taken care of here.

Again, thanks are due to Ray Helliwell for assisting on inspection duties.

THE DEREK OGDEN MEMORIAL LIBRARY

The library and archive is situated in the tower of Manchester Cathedral, but the available space in the tower for it is very limited. Many of the archive items such as old peal books are stored in plastic boxes in the intermediate chamber above the ringing chamber. There is a plan to rehang the Cathedral bells in the next few years, so these boxes may have to be moved again in the future. The bound copies of The Ringing World had been kept separately in the gallery of the nearby church of Sacred Trinity, Salford, but have now been removed as the church is planning to redevelop the space in the gallery.

I regularly receive enquiries about LACR members, towers, bells and peals which require perusal of the annual reports and peal books, but I have never received any enquiries which require study of old copies of ringing journals. The LACR has never actually owned a full set of bound Ringing Worlds or of any other ringing journal. All the ringing journals have now been donated to collectors or recycled.

All editions of 'Ringing World' (1911-1970), together with all editions of the old journals 'Church Bells' (1870-1906), 'Bell News' (1881-1915), 'Campanology' (1986-1897) and 'The Bellringer' (1907) can now be viewed on the Central Council website and copies can be downloaded by anyone for personal use free of charge:-

Copies of the DVD containing scanned copies of all annual reports up to 2019 are still available to LACR members to purchase at a cost of £10 each (including p&p/delivery). I have donated a copy of the annual reports DVD to the Central Council library.

I have been in correspondence with Mr Mark Jones, a non-ringer from Bristol, who was writing a book about old recordings of church bells, carillons and handbell ensembles published on shellac and vinyl records. The LACR library holds a number of old shellac 78's and vinyl LP's (remember those?) which I was able to assist him with. He has now published the book cataloguing all the available bell recordings, which contains acknowledgements both to me and the LACR. I have since unearthed a 78 of Mossley bells, and Mark is still collecting details of others that come to light. For updates see:-

2024 has been a busy year in the Furness and South Lakeland Branch. Equally, it seems to have slipped by quickly. Throughout the year, our monthly Branch meetings have been consistently well supported, the average attendance being 19 ringers with the highest being an amazing 28 ringers! Our Ringing Master, Anne, ensures that a wide programme of methods is attempted and all abilities and interests are catered for. Meetings always have a definite buzz!

During the year, several of our towers have regularly attracted ringers from various other towers to their weekly practices on 6, 8 and 10 bells, where opportunities to ring surprise minor and major are regularly available. Performances in the following methods have been achieved: Bob Doubles (4), Plain Bob Minor (2), Plain Bob Major (2), Grandsire Triples (1), Bristol Surprise Major (1), Cambridge Surprise Major (2), Cambridge Surprise Minor and a Peal of 7 minor methods. Congratulations to Andy (Barrow) who arranged a peal of Pudsey to be rung in Pudsey for Children in Need. Although this was not successful, their efforts raised over £1,000.00 for the charity! Two Branch training events have been organised during the year to help ringers who wanted to move from 6 bells to eight and also to help ringers who wanted to ring Plain Bob Minor accurately on an inside bell. Both of these sessions were held in response to requests from Branch members and were delivered by a representative of the Branch Committee as we currently do not have a Training Officer.

In March, celebrations were held to mark the 10th anniversary of the restoration and re-hanging of the ring of eight bells at St James the Great, Barrow. This attracted many ringers from outside our Branch. Since the restoration, the tower has flourished as a centre for learners and accomplished ringers. An important addition to the tower was their purchase and use of a Wombel which is now available for use at other locations.

During the year, we were pleased to elect 4 new members and we now have several more who are awaiting election as members in 2025. Very sadly, two of our long-standing members passed away during 2024. Ian Taylor had been a member of LACR since 1948 and had been the tower Captain at Ulverston for over 50 years, during which time he served as both Chairman and Representative to LACR. In December, Sandie Mills also passed away. She started her ringing career in Somerset at the age of 15. She became a member of LACR in 1984 and went on to be the Tower Captain of Cartmel Priory.

As well as being good fun, our Branch Striking competition also is an important fundraising event for our Branch. In 2024 it was held at St. Andrew's Church, Dent on a sunny evening in August. Four teams took part and the trophy went to the team from Dalton. The evening included a quiz and a fine buffet and raised over £100.00 for Branch Funds.

At our AGM in October our Treasurer, Mike Fletcher, decided to step down, having completed 15 years in the post. Thanks were extended to him for all his meticulous and conscientious work for the Branch. Treasurers are not always easy to find. However, at that meeting, we were pleased to elect David Robinson to follow Mike's excellent example.

Our year was brought to a close in the traditional way. Our Carol Service, including "seasonal refreshments", was held at the Church of St. John the Baptist, Flookburgh. Apart from lockdown, this has been the final event in our Branch year since 2011. As well as being an important way for our Branch to come together as a ringing family, we have, for some years, donated the funds raised to a charity nominated by the Church. We had a record congregation of over 45 people and donations for the evening amounted to a staggering £301.00! This was given to Cartmel Peninsula Holiday Food Boxes.

Branch activity in 2024 has been positive in many aspects. Another full calendar of monthly meetings has been held with attendances ranging from 6 to 45 members with all standard methods regularly rung as well as some Surprise. Turnout was overall higher than in 2023.

Membership of LACR is showing that the Branch is also growing (or at least more subscriptions are completed)! There are now almost 100 active members showing on the system, with Branch meetings seeing the voting in of new ringers from many of the towers.

Amongst the Branch towers there have been 36 QPs rung this last year. In 2023, the Coronation provided most towers a worthy cause to record a quarter, so to have surpassed that number (29) confirms a more active level of quarter peal ringing in a 'typical' year. Those ringing for their first Sunday services are also to be applauded as are new tower members embarking on their ringing careers.

The now very well-established St. Annes Ringing School (STARS) is providing additional learning facilities not just for Branch members from affiliated towers but also, ringers from a number of branches within LACR who have enrolled on their various courses, targeted practices and quarter peals arranged for development.

Intermediate level ringing continues to do well with members of the group making use of the practices to progress. Thanks to all of those who come along to help and support the learning of these methods. It does of course, provide a platform for those wanting to move to a more Advanced level...

Ringing will restart at The Willows, Kirkham in 2025 after significant renovations to the church. We remain hopeful of activity at Holy Trinity, Blackpool in preparing the ringing chamber for full inspection ahead of a possible rehang.

In summary, Fylde branch is active and growing in number with good support and camaraderie amongst the towers.

The highlight of 2024 was issuing two LACR proficiency certificates to two teenage members who show great promise for the future.

This has come from a mix of learners – from many towers within the branch but especially noticeable at Sacred Trinity, and also some experienced ringers either joining us here in Manchester or coming ringing more frequently. It is particularly encouraging that the Cathedral is practicing regularly with a larger and more diverse band than 12 months ago, which is really making it into a tower that is drawing more ringers to ring in Manchester.

There is still, inevitably, a reliance on a small number of people who tend to get involved with everything, many of whom are here today. It has been very noticeable when, through holiday, work or illness, one of these ringing stalwarts is not available – the support that they give to practices in the branch is invaluable. Thankfully, some of the new or returning ringers are contributing greatly to their towers in this regard, allowing a stronger base of ringers of all ages and abilities to be built up who support each other to improve the local ringing. I feel that we are returning to something closer to the situation pre-pandemic, but much work remains to be done in recruiting new ringers, making sure that they continue ringing, and also ensuring that they contribute fully to ringing locally.

This year's branch practices have certainly been, as is perhaps inevitable, variable in attendance. Of the ten practices since the last AGM, three (at Mossley, Fallowfield and Didsbury) have been well attended, two (Hyde and Stretford) have unfortunately seen no ringing due to low attendance and the other five (at Eccles, Flixton, West Didsbury, Gorton and Haughton) have been more marginal affairs – just enough for ringing to take place, but not quite enough attendees to have an especially successful practice. There has been a tendency for ringers from the host towers supporting the practices much more than having a mix of people from different towers coming together, but I think that the future is bright in this regard as we are building a larger core of ringers from multiple towers who ring together each week – converting this into support for branch practices will be critical.

One event worthy of particular mention was ringing for the coronation, with most towers within the branch ringing over the course of the weekend, including a quarters at Stretford, Haughton and Hyde, alongside a peal at the Cathedral. This was also an opportunity for some of the learners in the branch to get involved in ringing – even if their motivation wasn't necessarily linked to Ring for the King – and also allowed Manchester ringing to be reported in the press in the Netherlands. Thank you to everyone who helped organise ringing over the weekend.

For the coming year, I would suggest that the branch should have three objectives. The first, as of ever, has to be recruitment, training and retention of new ringers, which is always critical to the continuation of ringing. Secondly, there is the development of the ringers who we have currently, especially those who have joined us over the last year – ensuring that ringing provides enjoyment to them and then giving the motivation to get more involved over the coming year. Thirdly, we should look to develop branch events and the activities of the branch. I am hoping to produce a plan of practices which is more varied and interesting, hoping to make practices more of an 'event' with stronger regular support – this is also to feed into our hosting of the Lancs AGM. I also recognise that communications can also be improved, especially through better use of the contacts within towers already available. Finally, I am hopeful that with a new association ringing master, there is renewed interest in Association wide events, and that the branch can contribute to these events over the coming year.

PEAL SECRETARY'S REPORT

There were a total of 73 peals rung for the Association during 2024. This represents a continued slight decrease in the number of peals being rung annually. In 2022 post-pandemic there were 92 peals and in 2023 there were 84 peals. This seems to be partly due to there being fewer peal organisers active within the Association and partly due to the increase in average age of peal ringers in general.

The peals in 2024 were rung by 115 ringers in 41 towers. There were 16 conductors (reduced from 19 in 2022 and 2023.

Notable peals included:

The first peal in the tower at Over Kellet following the installation of the remodelled ring of bells from Church Kirk.

A peal at Liverpool Cathedral to mark the 100th anniversary of the consecration of the Cathedral.

A peal at Borwick was the first on the Taylors Touring Tower Bells, which were temporarily situated in the Climbing Wall at Borwick Hall. This peal marked the opening of the annual North West Ringing Course. One of the bells was donated by the Association.

The first peal rung on the newly augmented bells at Barnoldswick.

The first peal rung on the bells at Cockerham since 1974.

The 100th peal at Clitheroe.

Rochdale.

St Chad's Rochdale has a new ring of 10 bells, tenor 8-2-08, installed in 2024 when the church was celebrating its' 830th Anniversary. A bequest of 2 trebles to form a ring of 10 at Rochdale from the late John P Partington of Heywood was the catalyst for these new bells.

The main Contractor for the new installation was Blyth and Co of Newark and the scheme was project managed by Andrew Webster, a Rochdale ringer. The 2 new trebles were designed by Matthew Higby and Co and cast by Allanconi in Italy.

The back 8 bells were donated by the Manchester Diocese and are the 8 bells from St Mark's.





When this church was declared redundant the bells were rescued by the Keltek Trust on the understanding that they would be relocated to

The installation was completed in June 2024 and dedicated by the Bishop of Manchester in October 2024 at a service attended by many ringers.

Rochdale's old bells were purchased by the Keltek Trust and are now finding new homes in towers across the country.
